On weekdays 7:45–15, please enter the main entrance lobby on the 2nd floor. Follow the red continuous line to the X-ray Unit's registration. You will be instructed to the examination from there.

In other times, you can use the enter the main entrance lobby on the 2nd floor. Follow the orange line to the elevators of the N tower and arrive to the 1st floor. There is no need to register. Please wait in the elevator lobby until you are called in for the examination.

If blood samples have been requested for you, please visit the laboratory 2–7 days before the examination.

You have already received patient instructions for this examination. Prepare for the examination according to the provided instructions.

Please do not wear any strong fragrances when you come to the examination. Substances used in fragrances may cause serious symptoms in other people.

Please bring with you

Kela Card or identity card.

Cancelling and changing appointments

If you cannot come at the scheduled time, cancel the examination. Cancel the examination as soon as possible or by noon on the weekday preceding the appointment at the latest by calling the unit responsible for your care.
