If blood samples have been requested for you, please visit the laboratory 2–7 days before the examination.

If you are coming in for a mammography or an ultrasound, follow the black line on the floor in the X-ray unit to waiting area 1.

If you are coming in for a computed tomography (CT) follow the black line on the floor in the X-ray unit to waiting area 2.

A nurse will call you in by name.

Please do not wear any strong fragrances when you come to the examination. Substances used in fragrances may cause serious symptoms in other people.

Please bring with you

- Kela Card or identity card
- Any previous images from examinations performed in private health care

Cancelling and changing appointments

If you cannot come at the scheduled time, cancel the examination.

Cancel the examination as soon as possible or by noon on the weekday preceding the appointment at the latest by calling the unit responsible for your care.


