Register with the self-registration kiosk at the entrance.

You cannot register in the waiting room for computed tomography.

If you need assistance with registration on weekdays from 8 am to 3 pm, take the elevator to the 8th floor where you will find a secretary.

On weekday evenings, if necessary, you can ask for help from the hospital porters on the floor 0.

After registration, go to the 3rd floor using elevators number 1–5.

The elevators are near the hospital porters.

When you get out of the elevator, follow the instructions on the TV screen to the waiting room called 'Waiting Room for Computed Tomography'.

A nurse will call you in by name.

If blood samples have been requested for you, please visit the laboratory 2–7 days before the examination.

You have already received patient instructions for this examination.

Prepare for the examination according to the provided instructions.

Please do not wear any strong fragrances when you come to the examination.
Substances used in fragrances may cause serious symptoms in other people.

Please bring with you

- Kela Card or identity card
- Any previous images from examinations performed in private health care

Cancelling and changing appointments

If you cannot come at the scheduled time, cancel the examination.

Cancel the examination as soon as possible or by noon on the weekday preceding the appointment at the latest by calling the unit responsible for your care.
