Please register for an MRI at self-registration kiosk at the main entrance of the Women's Hospital (2nd floor).

You may register also at the MRI unit Monday- Friday 7.30 am–2.30 pm, on the 1st floor of the Women's Hospital.

Enter through the Women's Hospital main entrance and go to the left: the elevators are behind the corner.

Take the elevator to the 1st floor.

Please do not wear any strong fragrances when you come to the examination.  
Substances used in fragrances may cause serious symptoms in other people.

- Kela Card or identity card
- MRI Safety Questionnaire form completed

#### Cancelling and changing appointments

If you cannot come to your scheduled MRI examination, cancel or reschedule by calling the customer service for medical imaging at +358 9 471 80900 (Monday–Friday 8.00 pm–3.30 pm). Please cancel or reschedule the appointment no later than 12.00 noon on the previous working day.
