Entrance through door D on the ground floor.

Monday-Friday 7.45 am-3 pm register at the office on the ground floor.

From there, follow the yellow line on the floor to the elevators.

Take the elevator to the 2nd floor.

Follow the signs to Radiology (röntgen).

Open the radiology unit door by pressing the button.

In the radiology waiting area, ring the bell on the desk and take a seat to wait.

After 3 pm go straight to the X-ray unit. Ring the bell on the desk.

You have already received patient instructions for this examination. Prepare for the examination according to the instructions.

Please do not wear any strong fragrances when you come to the examination. Substances used in fragrances may cause serious symptoms in other people.
